





- Observation and hands-on experience in the classrooms














Consulted with MPS to determine weakest standards for focus Scantron Achievement Series Testing was used for pre and post testing

# On average, no loss in math or reading was experienced:

- •Reading: The greatest improvement in scores on average was a 7% gain across all three grade levels.
- •Math: On average, a 4% gain was experienced across all three grade levels.
